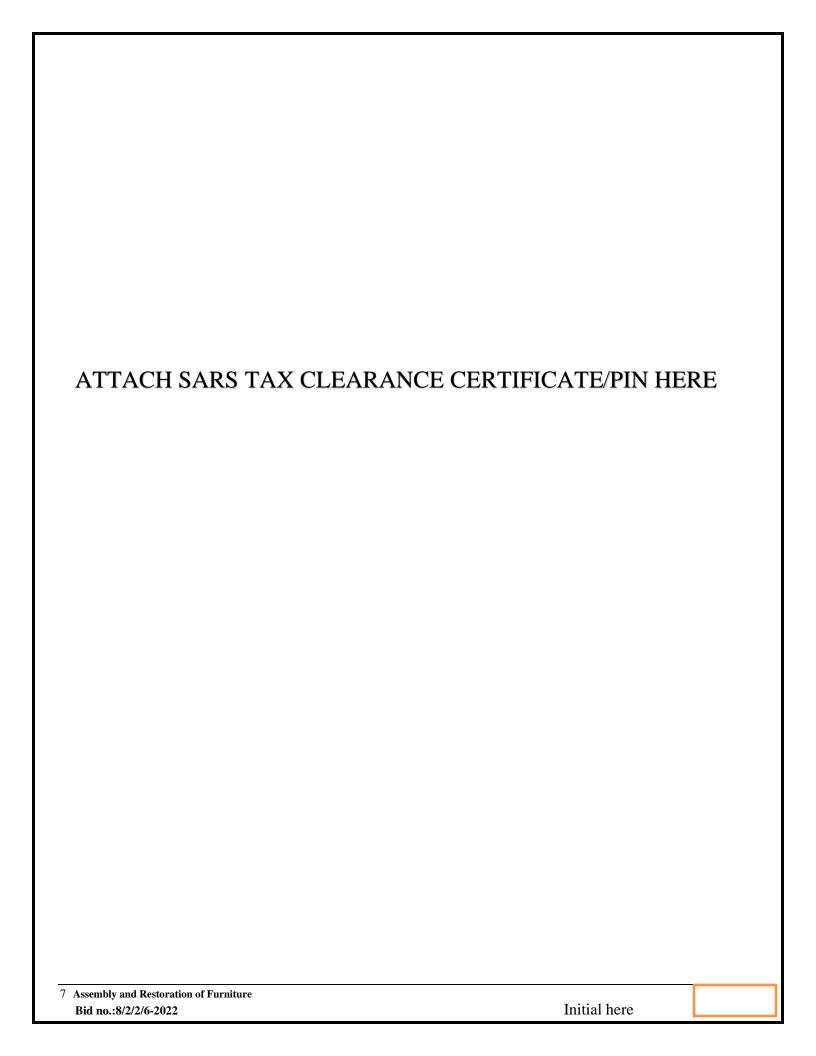

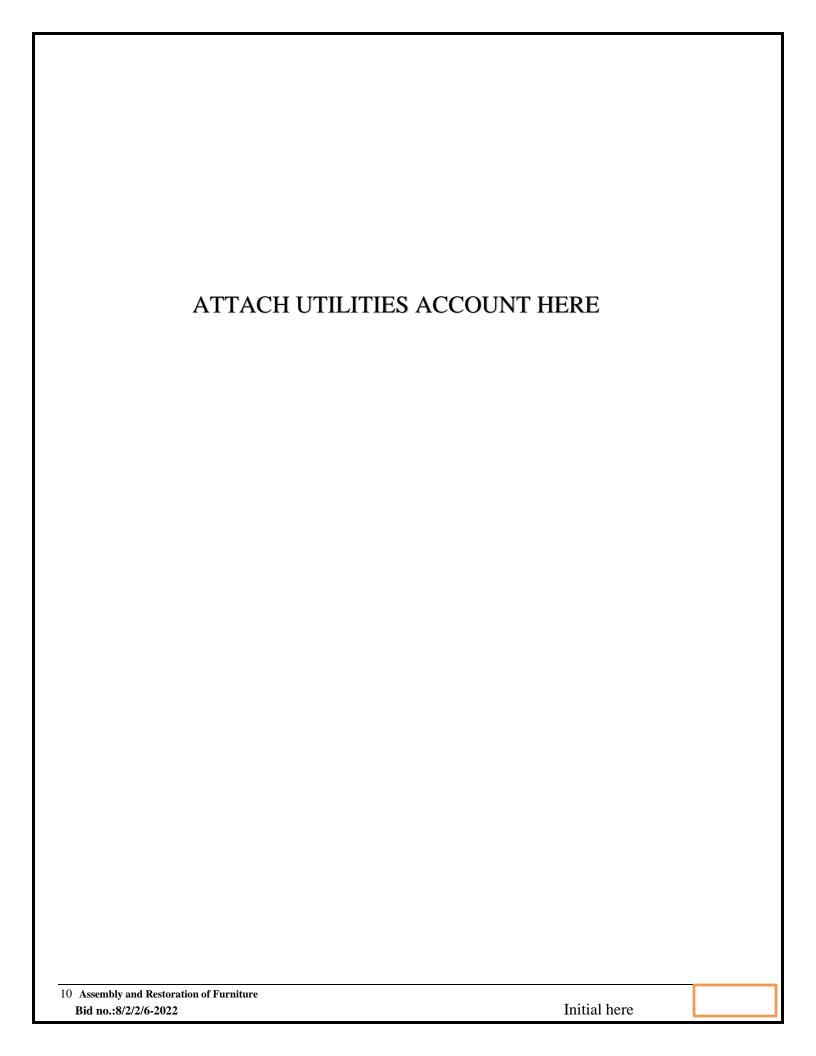

ASSEMBLY AND RESTORATION OF FURNITURE.

BID NO: 8/2/2/6-2022

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of these terms of reference is to request suitably qualified service providers to reassemble and restore office furniture for approximately 100 offices/ Open-Plans.

2. BACKGROUND

Sedibeng District Municipality *inter alia* occupied two privately owned buildings which were leased from the respective owners. The two buildings housed approximately 100 employees. In November 2021, upon the end of the rental contracts, Sedibeng appointed a contractor to disassemble all furniture of affected employees and the disassembled furniture was stored in various sites of Council. All parts of furniture were not stored together but split between the three sites and seven storage areas as listed hereunder:

- 1. Vaal Technorama
 - 1.1.Main Admin block foyer area
 - 1.2.Sharpeville Hall
 - 1.3.Leaders hall
- 2. Vereeniging Main Building Precinct
 - 2.1. Civic Theatre Parking basement level 01
 - 2.2.Main building Ground floor and 1st floor
- 3. Vereeniging Fresh Produce Market
 - 3.1.Cold storage room B
 - 3.2.Cold storage room D

The successful tenderer will be expected to assemble all furniture and either wrap the assembled furniture with the appropriate wrapping material OR to move the assembled furniture to a site as indicated by Council and install such furniture in workspace setup in offices as indicated by Sedibeng. No furniture and or parts of furniture will be removed from Council sites. All assembly will take place on Council sites as indicated by Council.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of this project will be in two parts being:

- A. Identify serviceable furniture which can be used immediately with limited assembly required. Such items to be transported to and placed at sites/offices in a workspace setup as required by Council.
- B. Remove all furniture and parts of furniture which require more complex assembly from various storage spaces to allocated area at Vereeniging Fresh Produce Market for re-assembly.

 Thereafter transport assembled furniture to sites/offices in a workspace setup as required by Council. (All possible sites for delivery will be in vicinity of Vereeniging)

Specific scope of work

- 3.1. Identify and group, per site, furniture and parts which can immediately be used / re-assembled and move such to sites as prescribed by Council.
- 3.2. Identify and group furniture and parts which belongs together and can be re-assembled. Move such furniture and parts to the Fresh Produce market open area for re-assembling.
- 3.3. Assemble furniture properly.
- 3.4. Identify and group furniture and parts which are beyond economic repair and submit a report on such to Council.
- 3.5. Upon successful re-assemble/renovation of furniture the furniture should either be wrapped and taken to storage space as identified by Council or taken to an identified office space and set up in workspace format. (During the course of the project Council will continuously advise the contractor as to the movement of assembled furniture.

Note to Bidders:

- The warrantee should not be less than 24 months on workmanship.
- The bidder must show proof of being a qualified furniture builder / carpenter
- Compulsory site briefing, as per item 4.5 hereunder will start at Vaal Technorama and continue to all sites/areas where furniture is currently stored.

- 2.4 **"bid"** means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of services, works or goods, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- 2.5 **"Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act"** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- 2.6 **"comparative price"** means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional discounts that can be utilized have been taken into consideration;
- 2.7 **"consortium or joint venture"** means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract;
- 2.8 "contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by an organ of state;
- 2.9 "EME" means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R5 million or less.
- 2.10 **"Firm price"** means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs or excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;
- 2.11 **"functionality"** means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- 2.12 "non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;
- 2.13 "person" includes a juristic person;
- 2.14 **"rand value"** means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties;
- 2.15 **"sub-contract"** means the primary contractor's assigning, leasing, making out work to, or employing, another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;
